

# CAUTION!

- Before riding, make sure the Tail Bag and all attachment points are connected correctly and do not interfere with the safe operation of the motorcycle as per these instructions.
- Do not exceed a maximum packed content weight of 10 pounds.
- Do not exceed the maximum load capacity of your vehicle's rear rack as specified by the manufacturer.
- When mounted, make sure the Tail Bag is centered on the bike.
- Make sure that weight is balanced and the heaviest items are on the bottom of the bag.
- Do not store sharp objects inside.
- Clean with mild soap and water only; do not use cleaning solvents.

Ride Responsibly. Safety is your first priority.  
Do not open, attempt to open or otherwise use bag while driving.

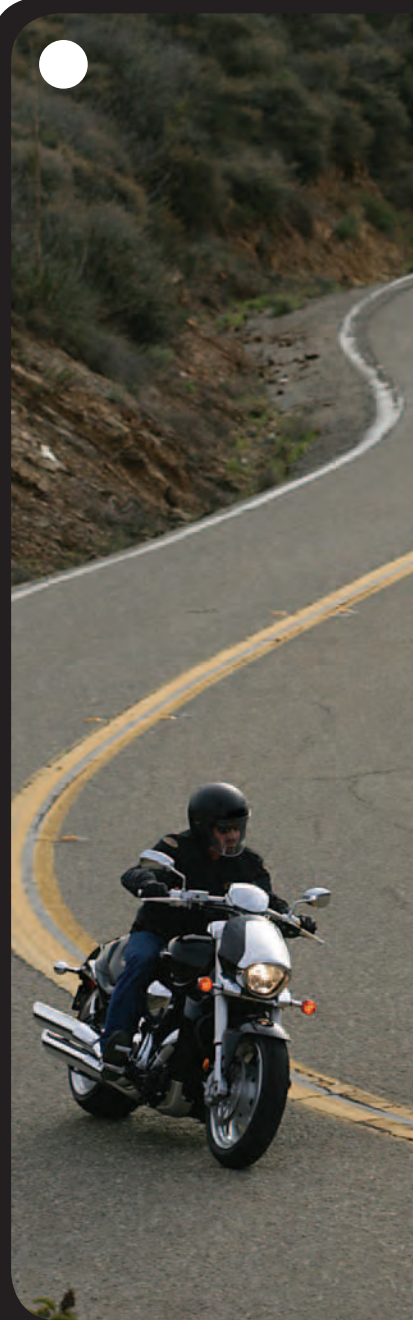

## MOUNTING INSTRUCTIONS ●



Tour Master's Deluxe Tail Bag attaches easily to most styles of motorcycles. The bag can be mounted on the passenger portion of a long saddle, on the rear fender, or on a rear motorcycle rack.

The two hidden bungee cords, which crisscross inside the bottom of the bag, can be attached to the frame at four points for a secure, stable mount. It is easier, but not necessary, to attach the Tail Bag if it is full and has some weight to help keep it in place while mounting.



To Install:

1. Center the bag where you want to ride (A).
2. Remove the bungee cords from the lower compartments on either side of the bag (B).
3. Grab the hooks from diagonal corners (which should be the same cord), and stretch the bungee to points on either side of the bike that require a strong pull to reach.
4. Repeat step 3 for the remaining hooks.

## ● MOUNTING INSTRUCTIONS



The bungees can easily be shortened if the location of attachment is too close for proper resistance.

It is important that the bag is centered over the motorcycle. Balance the load with the heaviest items at the bottom of the bag, to keep the center of gravity as low as possible.

The Deluxe Tail Bag is ruggedly built, and with its many compartments can contain many items, including a full-face helmet.



The Deluxe Tail Bag has a weight capacity of no more than 10 total pounds when fully loaded.

In the event of rain, there is a handy rain cover that stretches over the entire bag to keep it and the contents dry (C).

A little soap and water can keep the Deluxe Tail Bag looking good for a long, long time.
