

## MOUNTING INSTRUCTIONS

## CORTECH ATV BAGS & MITTS



### COOLER BAG

The Cortech® ATV Cooler Bag fits on the front or rear rack of most makes of ATVs. The adjustable buckle straps on each side of the bag fit around the rack bars for a secure placement.

1. Set the bag in a location where all straps can attach to rack bars.
2. Loosely attach straps until they are all in place. Tighten each strap until snug. The bag is now secure and ready to hit the trail.

The Cooler Bag's total weight carrying capacity is no more than 10 pounds when fully loaded.



### FENDER BAG

The Cortech® ATV Fender Bag fits on the rear fenders of most makes of ATVs.

1. Attach the top two adjustable buckle straps over the nearest bar on the rear accessory rack.
2. Attach the two lower elastic straps into the drain holes of the floorboards, or onto the frame if it is accessible.
3. Tighten straps for a secure fit.

The Fender Bag's total weight carrying capacity is no more than 5 pounds when fully loaded



### TANK SADDLEBAG

The Cortech® ATV Tank Saddlebag fits over the gas tank of most makes of ATVs. The rubberized underside protects the finish while it grabs the tank.

1. Remove the gas cap. Place the mounting yoke over the tank, centering it over the fuel opening. Replace the cap.
2. Attach the two lower straps into the frame or body on both sides. Tighten straps for a secure fit.

The Tank Saddlebag's total weight carrying capacity is no more than 5 pounds per side when fully loaded.



### GRIP MITTS

The Cortech® ATV Grip Mitts fit over each end of the handle bars on most makes of ATVs.

1. Place the mitt (drawstring end first) over the grip and levers, making sure that all controls are reachable with the hand inside the mitt.
2. Tighten the drawstring.
3. Repeat steps 1 and 2 on the opposite side.

A little soap and water can keep these handsome Cortech ATV bags looking good for a very long time.

### STRAP OPERATION

Straps go around the bar and into the buckle as shown at right (A).

Pull the end to tighten (B).
